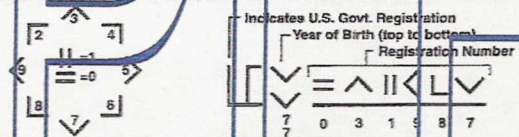
We received a request for information and duplicate paperwork for the wild horse you have acquired that has a Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Freezemark 94554971. We do not issue replacement or duplicate titles. Instead, we issue a letter certifying that the animal was titled. By way of this letter, we certify to you and anyone else that this may concern, that the wild horse with the U.S. Government's Freezemark 94554971/Signalment Key HF1ABAABB (Species: Horse Gender: Female Face Whorls: 1 Leg RF: No White Leg RH: Coronet Leg LF: No White Leg LH: No White Face Star Color: Bay) is titled, is no longer the property of the BLM, and is no longer protected under the Wild Free-Roaming Horse and Burro Act, 1971. This animal was captured from the Nevada Wild Horse Range in Nevada. The BLM issued a Certificate of Title for this animal on 11/19/1997.

The Bureau of Land Management does not record transfer of the animals after the animal has been titled.

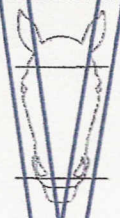

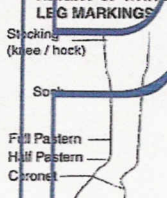

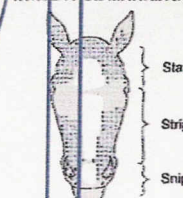
FACE WHORLS

STAR is a merging of these three marks:
Star
Blaze
Snip
BLAZE is a white marking covering almost all of the forehead but not including the eyes and nostrils.
SNIP is a white face including the eyes and nostrils.
