I have trained 1 of my own mustangs from gentling thru riding (Johwye), as well as gentling all my own. I have mentored, boarded and helped in the gentling of approximately 8-9 other mustangs since 1999. I have transported too many to count to new adoptive homes

I own 4 titled mustangs (ages 3-12) and 2 titled burros (ages 9-19) adopted from BLM from 1999-2007. I am not a MHF trainer. I am listed on BLM website as a trainer and mentor. I am currently working on gentling and pre-training # 5 & #6 fostered mustangs thru BLM foster program

I have exhibited mustangs and burros at Equine Affaire in MA 6 times for BLM and AMBA booth. (I am a former member of AMBA.)

I try to use a common sense method of training and work differently with each animal depending on their individual learning curves. I do not round pen per se, but use a similar method with body language. I prefer working with young horses and try to give them a solid base in ground work and de-sensitizing. I work on socializing with other horses, crowds of people, and trailer training so that their adopter or another trainer has no surprises and can continue to advance towards saddle training. I enjoy mentoring adopters so they may have the same feeling of accomplishment and bonding that I have enjoyed with my own mustangs.
