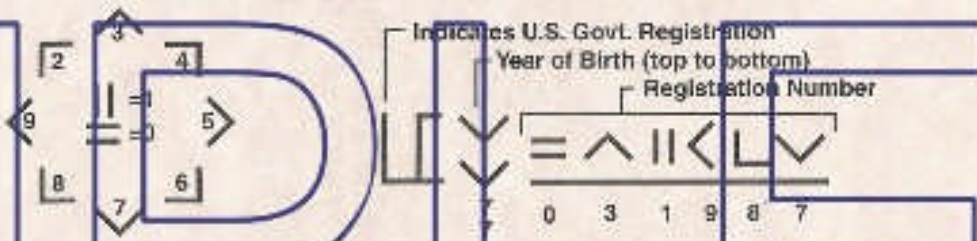


GENERAL INFORMATION

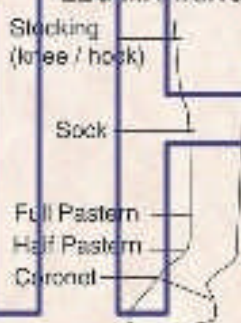

WHITE FACE MARKINGS



STAR, STRIP, and SNIP is a merging of these three marks:

Star BLAZE is a broad, white marking covering almost all of the forehead but not including the eyes and nostrils.

Strip BALD is a white face including the eyes and nostrils.
